From our flavoured tobacco report based on the YSS 2012/2013 data (https://uwaterloo.ca/canadian-student-tobacco-alcohol-drugs-survey/sites/ca.canadian-student-tobacco-alcohol-drugs-survey/files/uploads/files/yss12 flavoured tobacco use 20140910.pdf), we estimate that 29% of students in Canada in grades 9-12 who have smoked cigarettes in the last 30 days used menthol cigarettes in the last 30 days.

- **In Quebec**, 31% of students in Sec III-V (grades 9-11) who smoked cigarettes in the last 30 days had used menthol cigarettes in the last 30 days.

I have just checked the YSS 2012/2013 data. In Canada, 43% of daily smokers in grades 9-12 have used menthol cigarettes in the last 30 days.

- In Quebec, 47% of daily smokers in Sec III-V (grades 9-11) have used menthol cigarettes in the last 30 days.

Note that I have not checked the levels of error on these estimates or the significance of these differences.
